2. Choose a paid plan

My professional shared models are intended for paid ElevenLabs users, with Creator as the practical entry point for accessing higher-quality features and a more complete workflow. ElevenLabs currently lists Starter, Creator, Pro, Scale, Business, and Enterprise paid tiers, with Creator adding Professional Voice Cloning and 192 kbps audio, while Pro adds higher-end API audio output and Scale adds collaboration features. on this site to open ElevenLabs and create your account.

3. My recommendation

If you want the best balance of quality, credits, and flexibility, I recommend Pro.

If you generate heavily or work in production at a larger scale, Scale is a stronger fit.

If you are a company or agency, Business or Enterprise will usually make more sense. Enterprise is positioned for larger deployments, while Business and above are aimed at team usage and higher-volume workflows. ([ElevenLabs](#))

Arcadays

Warm conversational model for lifestyle content, podcasts, product walk-throughs, and human-centered brand communication.

Arcadees


Clear educational model for tutorials, lessons, step-by-step explainers, and structured information delivery.

Best Plan Choice

Best practical entry point

If you specifically want to use my professional shared models, treat Creator as the practical starting level.

Best overall recommendation

For most serious users, I recommend Pro.

It gives a stronger balance of credits, quality, and production flexibility than lower tiers. ElevenLabs' public pricing page currently lists Pro above Creator and below Scale, with larger included credit volumes and more advanced output options. ([ElevenLabs](#))

For heavier use

Choose Scale if you expect higher-volume generation, more iterations, or team collaboration. ElevenLabs currently positions Scale above Pro and includes multiple seats and team features. ([ElevenLabs](#))

For companies and agencies

If you are working as a company, studio, or agency, Business or Enterprise will usually be a better fit than individual creator tiers. ElevenLabs publicly positions these tiers for larger business use cases. ([ElevenLabs](#))
